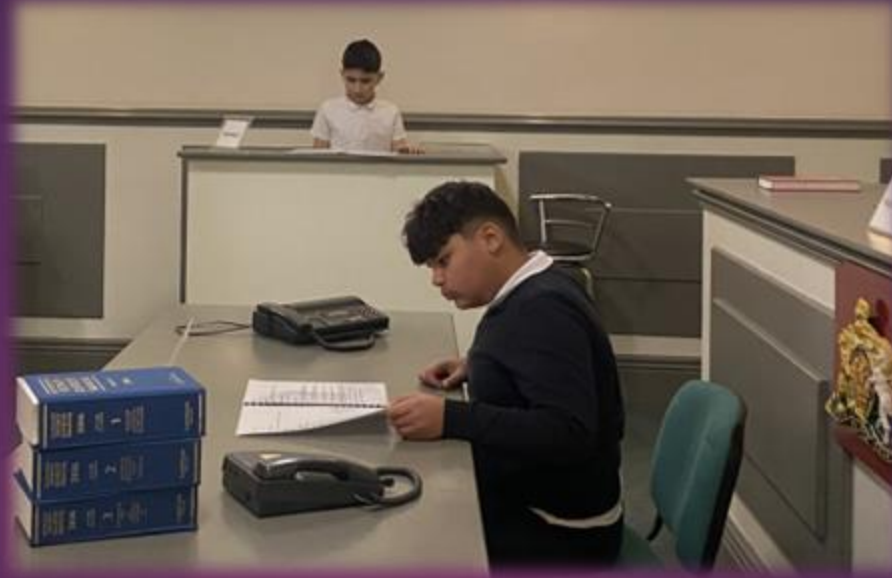

Purpose:

- ▶ To raise awareness of safety issues to our Year 6 class.
- ▶ Educating pupils through interactive scenarios, covering a wide range of topics, in a specific risk.
- ▶ Pupils will identify risks set up in the scenario and learn how to make their homes safer.
- ▶ Here are some examples of the areas how to stay safe...

Road Safety



- Pupils learned how to stay safe near the road
- They were taught how to cross roads safely
- They were reminded to wear bright, colourful clothing.

Water Safety



- Pupils learned how to stay safe and around water.
- They were taught how to spot a variety of dangers.
- They were reminded how to prevent drowning and how to potentially save lives.

Fire Safety



- Pupils learned about the dangers of electrical appliances.
- They were taught routines and safety checks needed to keep their homes safe.

Arson



- Pupils learned about arson.
- Pupils were taught that the deliberate destruction of property can lead to prison time.
- They learned that arson can lead to further crimes such as manslaughter.

Hate Crime



- Pupils learned about hate crime.
- Pupils were taught never to judge people on their religion, culture, language etc.
- They learnt about respect and tolerance of our own differences.

County Lines



- Children learned that they can be exploited by gangs.
- They can be sent to different towns/county within the United Kingdom to carry out tasks for these gangs.

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Outcomes:

- ▶ We evaluated how we can make our school happier and safer for all.
- ▶ Pupils have discussed how we can raise awareness of safety issues inside and outside of school.
