We discussed what we look like and what we enjoy doing in and outside of school. We identified the differences and similarities between us and the importance of respecting them.

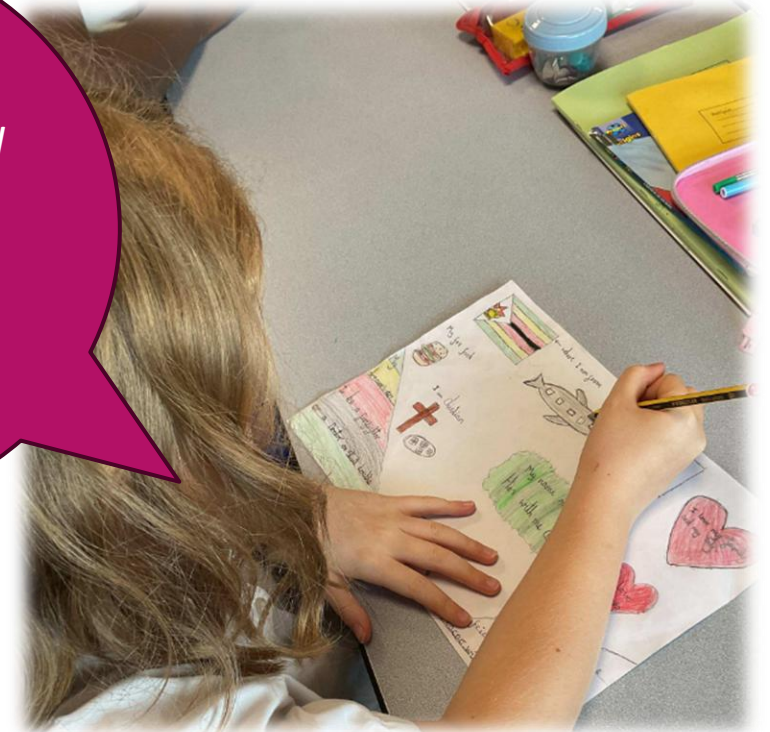


# Years 5 and 6 – Diverse Family Groups

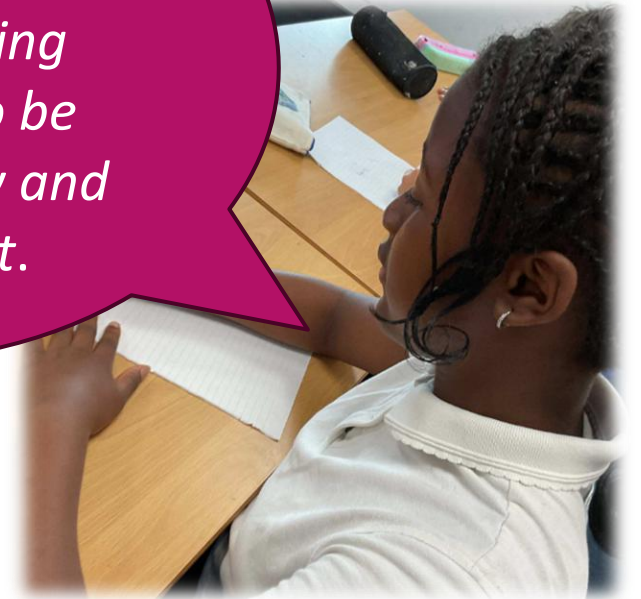


# Pupil Voice
